NOTICE OF FULL REDEMPTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by Vivendi S.A. (the “Company”) that, pursuant to Sections 3.01 and 3.02(b) of the Indenture (the “Indenture”), dated as of April 12, 2012, among the Company and U.S. Bank National Association, as trustee (the “Trustee”), on November 15, 2013 (the “Redemption Date”), the Company will redeem any and all of its outstanding 2.40% Notes due 2015 (the “Notes”) on such date. The redemption price will be equal to the greater of: (1) 100% of the principal amount of the Notes to be redeemed or (2) the sum of the present values of each remaining scheduled payments of principal and interest thereon (exclusive of interest accrued to the Redemption Date) discounted to the Redemption Date on a semi-annual basis (assuming 360-day year consisting of twelve 30-day months) at the Treasury Rate plus 30 basis points, plus accrued interest on the principal amount up to, but not including the Redemption Date (the “Redemption Price”).

The Notes called for redemption must be surrendered to U.S. Bank National Association, as paying agent, (the “Paying Agent”), at the address below or through the facilities of The Depository Trust Company, to collect the Redemption Price. On the Redemption Date, the Redemption Price will become due and payable on the Notes, and interest on the Notes will cease to accrue on and after the Redemption Date.

Federal income tax law generally requires paying agents making payments on securities to withhold 28% of such remittance from U.S. holders who have failed to furnish the paying agent with a valid taxpayer identification number (either from a social security or employer identification number, as applicable). The method of delivery of the Notes is at the election and risk of the Holder. If delivered by mail, certified or registered mail, properly insured, is recommended.
